NOTICE

Section one. Paragraph A of Section 154-2 of the Code of the Village of Great Neck Estates is hereby amended, to read as follows:

No person shall permit or cause the operation of any machinery, including lawn mowers, drills, power saws or other equipment:

(a) **between the hours of 7:00 pm on any day and 8:00 am on the following day,**

(b) **on Saturdays, for more than an aggregate of thirty (30) minutes at any one property,**

(c) **or at any time on Sundays or holidays, if such operation causes the emission of noise audible beyond the boundary of the property on which the machinery or equipment is located.**

SUMMARY OF RULES FOR GARDENERS AND LANDSCAPERS

Landscaping shall include, but is not limited to the cultivation, fertilization, seeding, planting, cutting, trimming, pruning or maintenance of grass, shrubs, plants, trees or other foliage. No landscaper shall perform any landscaping function within the Village without a license from the Village. No property owner or occupant shall allow any unlicensed landscaper to perform any landscaping function on his or her property.

Licenses can be obtained by the owner or corporate officer of the landscaping business. Application fee is \$50 PLUS annual license fee of \$50. All licenses expire on the last day of December of each year. The deadline for renewals is January 31. As of February 1, you will be required to reapply and pay a new application fee PLUS the annual license fee.

The following rules and regulations shall apply, in addition to all other applicable laws:

- a. NO PERSON SHALL LOAD or UNLOAD any equipment from any vehicle, truck or trailer OR OPERATE ANY MACHINERY including lawn mowers, blowers, drills, power saws or other similar equipment **BEFORE 8:00 A.M. or AFTER 9:00 P.M. or at any time on Sundays or Holidays.**
- b. NO PERSON SHALL PERMIT ANYONE TO BLOW OR RAKE LEAVES, GRASS OR OTHER DEBRIS ONTO THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR RIGHT-OF-WAY OR ONTO ADJOINING PROPERTY. A landscaper will be required to furnish proof of a permit to deposit leaves, grass clippings and other debris at a dumping facility. Leaves and debris MUST be removed from the property. You are NOT permitted to bag them for curbside pick-up.
- c. **USE OF GASOLINE or DIESEL-POWERED LEAF BLOWERS IS PROHIBITED FROM MAY 15 TO and INCLUDING OCTOBER 15.**
- d. NO person shall permit anyone to SPILL or dump OIL, gasoline or other petroleum products or any pesticides on the public highway or right-of-way or anywhere on the ground. No equipment shall be filled or refilled except over a drop cloth or other device designed to catch and retain any accidental spillage.
- e. NO TREE can be removed, destroyed or substantially trimmed on any property without the homeowner obtaining a permit from the Village.
- f. Snow and ice shall be cleared from sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours after snowfall or ice formation. Snow from private residential property is not to be placed in the roadway.

All work shall be performed in accordance with the laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations of the United States, New York, Nassau County and the Village. Every applicant for a license shall review the applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations and shall so state that the applicant and all of its employees are familiar with such, prior to the issuance of any license.
