

Great Neck Estates Department of Public Works
Monthly Report for December 2020

.Storm: Nor Easter hit at 4:00 pm on December 16th - plowed all Village streets and salted. Around 9 inches of snow.

Park: Routine items accomplished by the Department during the month are in BOLD.

- The Department spent 5 hours removing vines from trees and general clean up in Pond Park area during the month.
- We also continued collecting fallen leaves from the all of the park areas.
- Areas of grass were removed from the running paths of the baseball diamond, the areas were then scarified, leveled, and clay was added.
- **The Department continued to remove the fallen leaves on a routine basis from the park area.**
- **The collection of trash from the containers located in the parks continues on a routine basis. The Department has also been clearing the park grounds of assorted debris on a daily basis.**

Roads: Routine items accomplished by the Department during the month are in BOLD.

- Continued removing fallen leaves from Village roadways, traffic islands, and Village owned properties.
- Several street name signs and poles were replaced during the month and other parking enforcement signs.
- The Department continued sweeping the Village roadways of leaves and debris during the month.
- The Department cleaned the leaves from the upper level of the Municipal parking lot after notification was given to the residents of the Kenwood Apartment to have their cars moved from that area.
- **A morning trash pick-up from the Middle Neck Road containers, Municipal parking lot, Maple and Elm continued on a regular basis.**
- **The catch basins throughout the Village are being cleared of leaves and debris on a regular basis as well as before each forecasted rainstorm.**
- **Village owned properties and islands continue to be cleaned of fallen leaves and lawns were cut in those locations on a routine basis.**
- **The Department has continued sweeping the Village streets on a daily basis to remove the fallen leaves and debris gathered on the roadways.**

Miscellaneous:

- The leaf boxes were removed from the medium sized trucks and the appropriate sanders were installed, repaired and adjusted during the month.
- The Department replaced the plow blades on all of the truck's plows to begin this winter season.
